Moratorium policies: Jurisdictions, such as Santa Clarita, that have passed a moratorium on flavored tobacco sales are not included on this list of flavors laws. For PETS purposes, a moratorium is not considered to be equivalent to a law since these policies are temporary.

Repealed policies: Jurisdictions that have passed flavored tobacco policies and later repealed them are not included on this list of flavors laws. Delano enacted two flavored tobacco policies on 11/18/2019 and 3/16/2020 and later repealed them both on 11/16/2020.
